AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MOTOR VEHICLE TAX RATE FOR THE CITY OF MT. WASHINGTON, KENTUCKY FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2013 AND PROVIDING FOR COLLECTION
