This is a request to be removed as counsel of record in the above docket on the ground that my then client, Alcan Primary Products Corporation ("Alcan"), if in existence, no longer has an interest in this proceeding.

As background, on February 8, 2010 Michael L. Kurtz petitioned for full intervention on behalf of Kentucky Utility Industrial Customers, and I co-signed that pleading as co-counsel but for Alcan only. The motion was granted by the Commission by order dated February 23, 2010. I participated throughout the matter on behalf of Alcan.

As you are aware, the assets of Alcan were purchased by an affiliate of Century Aluminum Company, and Alcan Primary Products Corporation, if still in existence, has no further interest in and can no longer contribute to matters pertaining to this docket. If relevant, to my knowledge Century Aluminum Company or its affiliate continues to be a member of KIUC for the purpose of this proceeding.

By letter dated September 29, 2015, Big Rivers Electric Corporation filed a compliance report and this docket remains open for possible further action by the Commission. Under these circumstances, it is appropriate that David C. Brown of Stites & Harbison to be removed as counsel of record such that he and his firm have no further responsibility in this matter.
