KPSC Status Report LG&E Project - Resetting Gas Regulator Facility Operating Pressures (As of March 31, 2013)

March – Work Completed

Resetting operating pressures at gas regulation facilities supplying LG&E's various single feed distribution systems continued during March and resetting of operating pressures was started at facilities supplying LG&E's 35 psig distribution systems. During March the operating pressures were reset at 29 regulation facilities supplying single feed distribution systems and at 39 facilities supplying 35 psig systems for a total of 68 facilities reset during March. The single feed distribution systems combined serve 12,058 customers (approximately 4% of LG&E's total gas customers). The 35 psig distribution systems combined serve 149,103 customers (approximately 50% of LG&E's total gas customers).

April – Work Planned

In April, gas regulation technicians are scheduled to continue resetting operating pressures at gas regulator facilities for single feed distribution systems and resetting operating pressures on gas regulation facilities supplying LG&E's 35 psig systems.

Project Status Summary

Provided below is a table with completion percentages for resetting operating pressures of LG&E's distribution systems broken down primarily by pressure class. For each pressure class, the following data is provided: total customer count, total number of gas regulator facilities, number of gas regulator facilities that operating pressure has been reset, and percent complete for each pressure class.
