MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPORT

Comes Hillridge Facilities, Inc. ("Hillridge"), and, for the following reasons, hereby files its Motion for Extension of Time to File Report.

- On September 21, 2012, the Public Service Commission ("Commission") entered its Order approving the Louisville and Jefferson County Metropolitan Sewer District's ("MSD") acquisition of Hillridge's Sewage Treatment Plant and Collection facilities. The Order provided, among other things, that within 120 days of its entry, Hillridge was to file with the Commission a financial and statistical report for its sewer operations for the period from January 1, 2012, until the date of transfer of ownership to MSD (hereinafter "Report"). Accordingly, the Report was to be filed by Hillridge on or before January 28, 2013.
- 2. William Hollister, the accountant that has previously prepared Hillridge's annual reports filed with the Commission and who will be preparing and filing this Report, will need an additional sixty (60) days within which to complete the Report.
- 3. Hillridge hereby requests an additional sixty days from February 6, 2013, within which to file

the Report required by the Commission's Order of September 21, 2012.
