
**NOTICE OF TRANSFER**

Comes Hillridge Facilities, Inc. (“Hillridge”), and states that the closing of the sale of the Hillridge Facilities, Inc. (“Hillridge”), wastewater treatment plant and collection system to the Louisville and Jefferson County Metropolitan Sewer District (“MSD”) took place on Friday, August 17, 2012. Pursuant to the Bill of Sale executed by the parties at the August 17, 2012, closing, all of Hillridge’s right, title and interest in the Hillridge wastewater treatment plant and collection system was transferred to MSD on that date, subject to the approval of the Public Service Commission. Pursuant to the terms of the Assets Purchase Agreement entered into between Hillridge and MSD, Hillridge was to continue operating the wastewater treatment plant and collection system until September 30, 2012<sup>1</sup>.

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<sup>1</sup>A Motion to Expedite Joint Application for Approval of Transfer was filed in the above-styled action on August 30, 2012.


