- 1. Building A: (New Structure)
 - a. Brick has been completed
 - b. Stone is near completion
 - c. Roof panels continue
 - d. Exterior Insulation and Finishing System (EIFS) is complete on the 1st floor and is continuing on 2nd floor fascia
 - e. Drive thru and porches steel have been set
 - f. Window frames and glass have continued to be installed
 - g. Drywall hanging is continuing; it is complete on 1st floor trusses
 - h. Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing rough ends have continued on the 2nd floor
 - i. Metal stud framing is complete on 1st floor and 99% complete on the 2nd floor
 - j. Sprinkler Piping has started
 - k. Heat pumps have been hung and hydronic piping is started
 - 1. Plumbing has been inspected on the 1st floor

- 2. Building B: (Main Warehouse Renovations)
 - a. New Pre-engineered walls have been set
 - b. Ceiling joist have been completed over the office area
 - c. Exterior wall has been framed and wrapped with moisture barrier
 - d. Door frames are complete in office area
 - e. Metal siding has started
- 3. Building C, D, and E: (Ancillary Buildings)
 - a. Metal siding is complete on Buildings C, D and E
 - b. Steel framing is complete for new garage doors

Projections for the next 30 days include:

- 1. Building A: (New Structure)
 - a. Brick and stone will be completed
 - b. Window frames and glass will be completed
 - c. Roof panels should be complete
 - d. Site concrete will begin
 - e. Drywall will continue
 - f. Ceramic tile will begin

Fire Alarm Approval

Dear Martin S Friedman:

The Division of Building Code Enforcement has reviewed the fire alarm plans submitted by your organization for compliance with the Kentucky Building Code (KBC) and the 2010 NFPA 72, National Fire Alarm Code. We find the plans are acceptable to this office and meet the intent of the code as established by the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Please note the plans were reviewed only for appliance type, location and listing. Audible alarm notification appliances shall be installed in accordance with Section 907.5.2 of the 2013 KBC, Section 702 of the ANSI A117.1, 2009 and Section 18.4 of the 2010 NFPA 72. Fire alarm systems noted as being "NON-REQUIRED" may be furnished for partial or complete protection provided such installation meets the applicable functional test requirements of the code. Compliance with the current National Electrical Code (NEC) shall be determined by a state certified electrical inspector whose services must be contracted separately by the owner or authorized agent. Our failure to note any violations does not relieve the installer from the responsibility for installing the system in compliance with applicable codes.

Upon completion of the installation, a test of the system shall be performed in the presence a representative of this office or the owner's agent. A copy of the final materials and test certificate shall be forwarded to this office. If you have any questions, please feel free to call or write me at the noted addresses.
