Dear Director Chandler.

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:069, Section 4 and Ordering Paragraph #7 of the PSC Order dated July 16, 2019 in Case Number 2019-00180, the Todd County Water District hereby notifies the Kentucky Public Service Commission of the following additional construction regarding the Todd County Water District's Novelis Water Supply Project. The District plans to utilize the remaining contingency funds plus a small amount of our own funds to construct the following additional work items:

- Contract 3 (Line Extension & Meter Vaults; Bid Value @ \$218,200, anticipated final cost of \$157,500)
  - 1,300 LF of 3" Waterline Extension along Latham Road
  - o Optional 3,790 LF of 3" Waterline Extension along Davenport Road, which will likely be postponed.
  - o Addition of 5 new master meter vaults, some including PRV's, in various useful locations within the county.
- SCADA Improvements at the North Todd Pump Station (Total Estimated cost of \$37,500)

No change in rates will result from this additional construction.

A letter from the lending agency, USDA, Rural Development, authorizing the use of the surplus project contingency funds for the above construction is attached hereto.
