Dear Mr. DeRouen:

Pursuant to the Commission's Order in the aforementioned case, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") hereby notifies the Commission that virtually all work for the relocation of LG&E facilities and the construction of the transmission dispatch facility is complete. Due to the construction of a parking garage by the Galt House owners on the adjacent property, LG&E has agreed to allow the south driveway to be used as a construction entrance and, therefore, the driveway cannot be completed until the garage is completed. The completion of all related work is expected by the end of 2010. The entries below include an estimate of \$220,000 for the completion of this work, a very small portion of the overall Arena related work. If the completion of the remaining work exceeds the estimate included below by more than 10%, revised entries will provided upon completion.
