





Department of Transportation have worked together to construct the computer-based registry.

The registry allows Kentuckians willing to be donors to place their names on a list that is accessible only to organ procurement organizations on a 24-hour basis. Until then, Kentuckians could only sign the back of their driver's licenses or donor cards and talk to their families about their wishes. Both actions are still encouraged, but their willingness to donate was not recorded and therefore not always available at the time of their death.
