

The monthly charge for water usage in excess of the respective minimum water rates set out above shall be computed in increments of 10 gallons. Accordingly, a customer having a 5/8 inch meter who consumes at least 2,010 gallons of water and not more than 2,019 gallons of water in any month shall pay the amount of \$15.50 for the month (\$15.54 plus \$0.05). A customer having a 5/8 inch meter who consumes at least 2,020 gallons and not more than 2,029 gallons of water in any month shall pay the amount of \$15.56 (\$15.45 plus \$0.11).

The foregoing rates are rates to be charged by the District and any applicable State Sales Tax and School Tax shall be added to each bill.




