## **NOTICE**

Comes Coolbrook Utilities, LLC ("Coolbrook"), by counsel, and states as follows:

- 1) In the above-styled administrative action, Coolbrook requested authority to assess a monthly surcharge of \$6.75 for a 12 month period to fund the cost of an inflow and infiltration ("I & I") study to be performed on its collection system. On May 10, 2012, the Commission held a hearing in this matter and, among other things, heard evidence concerning the proposed surcharge.
- During the May 10, 2012, hearing, Coolbrook submitted evidence that it had obtained quotes of the cost to clean and inspect by video camera its collection system's main sewer lines from Leak Eliminators, LLC, and Martin's Pipeline Inspection in the amount of \$35,200 and \$38,400, respectively. Coolbrook also introduced evidence establishing that it did not have the funds to pay for the cost to clean and inspect by video camera its collection system's main sewer lines nor was it able to borrow from financial institutions the money needed to perform the I & I study.
- 3) The Commission's Order of August 30, 2012, authorized Coolbrook to assess a monthly surcharge of \$3.00 for a period of 12 months subject to the conditions set forth in the Order.
- 4) Because it does not have the financial wherewithal to pay for the cost of the I & I study. Coolbrook has not entered into a contract for the performance of such a study.
