14 15	1. Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers") hereby petitions the K	entucky	
16	Public Service Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 Section 13 and KRS		
17	61.878, to grant confidential protection to certain information Big Rivers is filing with this		
8	petition. The information Big Rivers seeks to protect as confidential is hereinafter referred to as		
19	the "Confidential Information."		
20	2. The Confidential Information consists of "as built" drawings of the tw	ro	
21	transmission lines for which the Commission granted a certificate of public convenience and		
22	necessity in its August 4, 2015, order in this matter.		
23	3. The entirety of the "as built" drawings is confidential. As such, one	l) sealed	
24	copy of the drawings marked "CONFIDENTIAL," is being filed with this petition, and an		
25	original and ten (10) copies of a sheet noting the entirety of drawings has been redacted are being		
26	filed with this petition. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 13(2)(a)(3).		
27	4. A copy of this petition with the Confidential Information redacted has	been served	
28	on all parties to this proceeding. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 13(2)(b).		
29	5. The Confidential Information is not publicly available, is not dissemin	nated within	
30	Big Rivers except to those employees and professionals with a legitimate business need to know		

- 1 and act upon the information, and is not disseminated to others without a legitimate need to
- 2 know and act upon the information.
- 3 6. If and to the extent the Confidential Information becomes generally available to
- 4 the public, whether through filings required by other agencies or otherwise, Big Rivers will
- 5 notify the Commission and have its confidential status removed. 807 KAR 5:001 Section
- 6 13(10)(b).
- 7. The Confidential Information is entitled to confidential protection based upon
- 8 KRS 61.878(1)(m)(1), which protects "[p]ublic records the disclosure of which would have a
- 9 reasonable likelihood of threatening the public safety by exposing a vulnerability in preventing
- 10 protecting against, mitigating, or responding to a terrorist act. . . . "
- 11 8. The Confidential Information includes critical energy infrastructure information
- in the form of a detailed map of the relevant portion of Big Rivers' transmission system and a
- diagram showing in detail certain transmission system structures and components, including line
- placements, interconnections, and elevations. As disclosure of this information would provide
- the public with detailed schematics of the Big Rivers transmission system, this information
- should be granted confidential treatment. The Commission granted confidential treatment to
- similar information including preliminary diagrams and maps, in its January 15, 2016, order in
- 18 this matter.
- 9. Big Rivers requests that the Confidential Information remain confidential
- 20 indefinitely because as long as the transmission system remains in place, the information should
- be confidential for the reasons stated above. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 13(2)(a)(2).
- 22 10. Based on the foregoing, the Confidential Information is entitled to confidential
- 23 protection. If the Commission disagrees that Big Rivers is entitled to confidential protection, due

1 process requires the Commission to hold an evidentiary hearing. See Utility Regulatory Com'n v. 2 Kentucky Water Service Co., Inc., 642 S.W.2d 591 (Ky. App. 1982). 3 WHEREFORE, Big Rivers respectfully requests that the Commission classify and protect 4 as confidential the Confidential Information.
