In November 2022, South KY RECC tested meter # 221057 that was located in your building at Dunmeyer Road in Russell County. This meter tested stopped during periodic testing at the Somerset office of South Kentucky RECC.

Per Public Service Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:006, we are required to collect the amount of usage during the time frame we estimate the meter was stopped. An adjustment to your account will be made for that time period.
