The rates set forth in Appendix B to the Order are approved effective with the first billing cycle of the month following the issuance of this Order. 4. Duke Kentucky shall continue to file a DSM application annually by August 15 containing an analysis of the impact of DSM charges on its electric and gas customers' bills, detailed evaluations of the cost-effectiveness of its existing programs, and any proposed revisions to programs in light of the attendant cost burdens to the residential and commercial classes. 5. Within 20 days of the date of entry of this Order, Duke Kentucky shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised electric and gas tariff sheets setting forth the rates approved herein and reflecting that they were approved pursuant to this order. 6. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.

The Attorney General shall comply with all provisions of the Commission's regulations, 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, related to the service and electronic filing of
documents. 4. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(9), within seven days of entry of this Order, the Attorney General shall file a written statement with the Commission that:
