(1) Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. ("Duke Kentucky") shall appear at the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Blvd, Frankfort, Kentucky on March 23, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. to submit itself to examination on the application of its Fuel Adjustment Clause from May 1, 2009 through October 31, 2009.
(2) Duke Kentucky Power shall file with the Commission no later than March 23, 2010 proof of publication of its notice for the hearing.
(3) a. The information requested in the Appendix to this Order is due within 21 days of the date of this Order.
(3) b. Each response shall be answered under oath.
(3) c. A party shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which was incorrect when made.
(3) d. Any request a party refuses to furnish the requested information, that party shall provide a written explanation.
(4) Any party who wishes to file testimony in this proceeding or to request information from Duke Kentucky may petition the Commission for a procedural schedule.
(5) All documents that Duke Kentucky filed with the Commission pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, Section 1(7) and (9), during the period under review are incorporated by reference into the record of this proceeding.
(6) The official record of the proceeding shall be by video only, unless otherwise requested by a party to this proceeding.
