(1) Farmers' proposed rates are suspended for six months, up to and including January 7, 2011.  
(2) The procedural Schedule set forth in the Appendix shall be followed.

(3) b. Each response shall be answered under oath.  
(3) c. Any party shall make timely amendment to any prior response.  
(3) d. For any request a party fails to furnish the requested information, that party shall provide a written explanation.  
(4) Any party filing testimony shall file an original and 10 copies with the Commission with copies to all parties of record.  
(5) Farmers shall give notice of the hearing in accordance with the provisions set out in 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8(5).  
(6) At any public hearing, neither opening statements nor summarization of direct testimony shall be permitted.  
(7) Any objections shall be filed upon four business days' notice.  
(8) Motions for extension of time with respect to the schedule shall be made in writing.  
(9) Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
