  - (5) a. The information requested in the Appendix is due not later than 21 days from the date of this Order.
  - (5) b. Each response shall be answered under oath.
  - (5) c. A party shall make timely amendment to any prior response.
  - (5) d. Any request a party refuses to furnish the requested information, that party shall provide a written explanation.
  - (6) Any party who wishes to file testimony in this proceeding may petition the Commission for a procedural schedule.
  - (7) All documents that KU filed with the Commission during the period under review pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, Section 1 (7) and (9) are incorporated by reference into the record of this proceeding.
