exceed 310 feet in height, with attached antenna, and is to be located on a tract of land located at 2442 Fish Trap Road, Manchester, Clay County, Kentucky. The coordinates for the proposed facility are

2. The Applicant shall file a copy of the final decisions regarding the pending FAA and KAZC

3. The Applicant shall immediately notify the Commission in writing, if, after the antenna tower is built and utility service is commenced, the tower is not used for a period of three months in the manner

authorized by this Order.
