Outside of the issues addressed in previous Commission Orders for the two year review period, the charges and credits applied by Duke Kentucky through the FAC for the period from November 1, 2012, through October 31, 2014, are approved. 2. Duke Kentucky's proposed base fuel cost of 29.117 mills per kWh is approved. 3. Duke Kentucky shall transfer (roll-in) 1.651 mills per kWh of fuel costs to its base rates. 4. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are approved effective with Duke Kentucky's first billing cycle for September 2015. 5. Beginning with the expense month for September 2015, Duke Kentucky shall use an FAC rate based upon a base fuel cost of 29.117 mills per kWh. 6.
