If the actual terms and conditions of the agreement with KRWFC differ from those set forth in its application, Henderson County shall, within 30 days of executing the loan agreement, file with the Commission amortization schedules and work papers showing the actual gross savings and net present value savings that will result from the refinancing. 3. Within 30 days of executing the proposed agreement, Henderson County shall file a copy of the executed Assistance Agreement and any documents referenced in the executed Assistance Agreement that Henderson County has not previously filed with the Commission. 4. The proceeds from the Assistance Agreement shall be used only for the lawful purposes specified in Henderson County's application. 5. Any documents filed pursuant to ordering paragraphs 2 and 3 of this Order shall reference the number of this case and shall

be retained in the utility's general correspondence file.
