As there is no line loss adjustment for direct-served customers, Fleming-Mason shall deduct \$.00238 per kWh from the base energy rate applicable to its direct-served customer. 3. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are approved for service rendered by Fleming-Mason on and after September 1, 2017, the effective date of East Kentucky's change in rates. 4. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Fleming-Mason shall file, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, its revised tariff sheets with the Commission setting out the rates approved herein

and reflecting that they were approved pursuant to this Order.
