Kentucky Power shall use a weighted average cost of capital of 6.44 percent and a tax gross-up factor of 1.352116, a return on equity rate of 9.70 percent, and an overall grossed-up return of 7.88 percent in all monthly environmental surcharge filings subsequent to entry of this Order. 5. The environmental surcharge amounts determined by Kentucky Power for the two-year review period ending June 2017 are just and reasonable.
