A copy of any written material given to water district commissioners attending the presentations, as well any changes to the written materials that were submitted in the application; and e. Documents indicating whether the Kentucky Bar Association has approved the training for Continuing Legal Education Credit, or whether the Department of Local Government, has approved Elected County Officials Training Incentive Program Credit.
