5. Kentucky-American shall submit an application to the Commission prior to issuing any securities that require approval pursuant to KRS 278.300. 6. Kentucky-American shall file with the Commission documentation of the total costs of this project, including the cost of construction and repairs and all other capitalized costs, (e.g., engineering, legal, administrative) within 60 days of the date that construction authorized under this CPCN is substantially completed. Construction and repair costs shall be classified into appropriate plant accounts in accordance with the Uniform System of Accounts for water utilities prescribed by the Commission.
