BREC shall file with the Commission no later than October 8, 2018, proof of publication of its notice for the hearing. 4. The official record of the proceeding shall be by digital video recording only. 5. a. The information requested in the Appendix to this Order is due no later than 14 days from the date of entry of this Order. Responses to requests for information in paper

medium shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed. Electronic documents shall be in portable

document format (PDF), shall be searchable and shall be appropriately bookmarked.
