The proposed facility consists of a tower not to exceed 270 feet in height, with attached antennas, to be located at 3575 Elkhorn Road, Knifely, Adair County, Kentucky. The coordinates for the proposed facility are North Latitude 37°12'35.49" by West Longitude 85°10'49.52." 2. AT&T Mobility shall file a copy of the final decision regarding the pending KAZC application for the proposed construction within ten days of receiving the decision.  
 3. AT&T Mobility shall immediately notify the Commission in writing if, after the antenna tower is built and utility service is commenced, the tower is not used for three months in the manner authorized by this Order. 4. Any documents filed in the future pursuant to ordering paragraphs 2 and 3 shall reference this case number and shall be retained in the post-case correspondence file. 5. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
