367.4911 (1)(a) for failure to provide Atmos Energy Corporation the operator of an underground facility serving the public with notification of its intended work and work schedule not less than two (2) nor

more than ten (10) full working days prior to commencement of work.

Hayden shall pay one thousand dollars (\$1,000) by cashier's check or money order payable to the Kentucky State Treasurer and mailed or delivered to the Kentucky Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY 40602 within thirty (30) days of the date of this order. 3. The Kentucky Public Service Commission will hold a damage prevention training course at its offices located at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY on September 9, 2019 beginning at 1:00 o'clock p.m. and lasting until approximately 3:00 o'clock p.m. Eastern Daylight Time. If Hayden, through an agent, servant or employee attends the above training course the additional one thousand dollars

(\$1,000) assessed in numerical paragraph 2 of this order will be vacated.
