This proceeding is established to (1) investigate the reasonableness of the GCR component of Johnson County's rates and rates charged by Hall between April 1, 2013, and September 3, 2019, and (2) to ensure that Johnson County's current and future efforts to procure the lowest cost gas for its customers, irrespective of supplier, are reasonable, and that its gas cost is likewise appropriately market based. 2. Within 20 days of the date of entry of this Order, Johnson County and Hall shall submit to the Commission a written response to the allegations contained in this Order. 3. Johnson County shall collect the GCR component of its rates subject to refund effective for bills rendered after the date of this Order until further Order of the Commission.
