Joint Applicants shall retain a record of all water district commissioners attending the Training Program. 4. No later than 45 days after the scheduled training program, Joint Applicants shall file with the Commission: a. A sworn statement attesting that the accredited instruction was performed; b. A description of any changes in the presenters or purposed curriculum that occurred after the application; c. The name of each attending water district commissioner, his or her water district, and the number of hours that he or she attended; and d. A copy of any written material given to water district commissioners attending the presentations if not previously provided. 5. Upon receipt of the materials identified in paragraph 4 and provided there are no material changes to the program, the Commission shall issue a final Order approving and accrediting the Training Program.
