The proposed facility consists of a tower not to exceed 305 feet in height, with attached antennas, to be located on East Fork Road, Edmonton, Metcalfe County, Kentucky 42129. The coordinates for the proposed facility are North Latitude 37° 01' 52.38" by West Longitude 85° 31' 03.08". 2. Joint Applicants shall immediately notify the Commission in writing if, after the antenna tower is built and utility service is commenced, the tower is not used for three months in the manner authorized by this Order. 3. Documents filed, if any, in the future pursuant to ordering paragraph 2 herein shall reference this case number and shall be retained in the post-case correspondence file. 4. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
