Assuming the replacements will not result in wasteful duplication, the ongoing replacements of about 500 meters and ERT modules a year with the Intelis 250 meters due to maintenance issues is an ordinary extension in the usual course of business, and a CPCN, pursuant to KRS 278.020(1), is not required. 4. Except with respect to the replacements discussed in ordering paragraph 3, the Commission declines to decide whether a CPCN is required for the future replacement of the 32,000 ltron 100s, or their respective meters, once either has reached the end of their service life. 5.
