For PRP years beginning after the entry of this Order, Atmos's PRP rider shall be subject to a \$40 million annual recovery cap and shall allow the recovery of expenditures to replace bare steel and Aldyl-A pipeline. Atmos shall not propose changes to the PRP mechanism in its annual PRP filings. Atmos shall use the PRP ROE approved in this case in future PRP filings until the next rate case order. 5. Atmos's PM Rider is approved only for the projects listed in Exhibit TRA-5 to Mr. Austin's Direct Testimony. Projects to be initiated under this rider shall require a CPCN application to be approved prior to commencement of work. A CPCN shall not be required for any of these projects commenced prior to the issuance of this Order for which a CPCN would not otherwise be required. 6. Atmos's proposed tax rider is denied.
