Order Entered: 1. An investigation into the reasonableness of Wood Creek District's termination of water service to Livingston, and Livingston's alleged failure to manage and maintain an adequate and reliable supply of water to Kentucky-American is hereby established. 2. Wood Creek District and Livingston shall file a response to this Order and the allegations contained herein no less than 20 days after the date of service of this Order. 3. Any interested party may, by counsel, file a motion to intervene within 14 days of the date of service of this Order or, if not served the Order, within 30 days of the issuance date of the Order. 4. As set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(11)(a), a person requesting permissive intervention in a Commission proceeding is required to demonstrate either (1) a special interest in the proceeding that is not adequately represented in the case, or (2) that the person requesting permissive intervention is likely to present issues or develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings.
