EKPC shall also file documentation showing the quotes that EKPC relied upon to determine the lowest interest rate. 4. EKPC shall agree only to terms and prices consistent with the parameters set forth in EKPC's application. 5. Any documents filed in the future pursuant to ordering paragraph 3 of this Order shall reference this case number and shall be retained in EKPC's post-case correspondence file.
