Every 45 days beginning from the date of issuance of this Order, South Kentucky RECC shall file the following: a. Specific breakdown of expenditures, b. Specific breakdown of funding, including reimbursements; c. If necessary, financing, even if it does not require Commission approval pursuant to KRS 278.300; and d. Progress reports reflecting any actions taken to rebuild or repair any building on the South Kentucky RECC premises. 4. South Kentucky RECC shall obtain the approval of the Commission prior to performing any additional construction not expressly authorized by this Order. 5. South Kentucky RECC shall furnish documentation of the total costs of this project, including the cost of construction and all other capitalized costs, together with, but not limited to, engineering, legal, and administrative expenses, within 60 days of the date construction is substantially completed. Constructions costs shall be classified into appropriate plant accounts in accordance with the Uniform System of Accounts for electric utilities as prescribed by the Commission.
