02/26/26 Order Entered: 1. Henderson District's August 29, 2025 motion for confidential treatment is granted. 2. The designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order shall not be placed in the public record or made available for public inspection for an indefinite period or until further order of this Commission. 3. Use of the designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order in any Commission proceeding shall comply with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(9). 4. If the designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order becomes publicly available or no longer qualifies for confidential treatment, Henderson District shall inform the Commission and file with the Commission an unredacted copy of the designated material. 5. If a nonparty to this proceeding requests to inspect the material granted confidential treatment by this Order and the period during which the material has been granted confidential treatment has not expired, Henderson District shall have 20 days from receipt of written notice of the request to demonstrate that the material still falls within the exclusions from disclosure requirements established in KRS 61.878. If Henderson District is unable to make such demonstration, the requested material shall be made available for inspection. Otherwise, the Commission shall deny the request for inspection.

02/16/26 Final Order Entered: 1. Henderson District's request for a declaratory order is granted, in part, and denied, in part. 2. The proposed project is an ordinary extension in the usual course of business, and therefore, a CPCN, pursuant to KRS 278.020(1), is not required. 3. Henderson District was not required to obtain prior Commission approval before entering into the Grant Agreement. 4. On or before May 1, 2026, Henderson District shall review its QIIP in light of the projects proposed herein and file, in Case No. 2023-00333, either an updated QIIP or a detailed explanation of why an updated QIIP is not necessary in light of the projects proposed in this case. 5. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
