The amounts billed by the three Member Cooperatives through their respective environmental surcharge pass-through mechanisms for the two-year review periods billed beginning August 1, 2023, through July 31, 2025, for all customers with dedicated delivery points are approved. 5. The amounts billed by the three Member Cooperatives through their respective environmental surcharge pass-through mechanisms for the two-year review periods billed beginning September 1, 2023, through August 31, 2025, for all other non-dedicated delivery point customers are approved. 6. BREC and each of its Member Cooperatives shall respond to any additional requests for information propounded by Commission Staff as provided in those requests. 6.
