The proposed facility consists of a tower not to exceed 265 feet in height, with attached antennas, to be located in Graves County at 7960 State Route 58 E, Mayfield, Kentucky 42066. The coordinates for the proposed facility are North Latitude 36° 46' 39.13" by West Longitude 88° 30' 24.97". 2. Joint Applicants shall immediately notify the Commission in writing if, after the antenna tower is built and utility service is commenced, the tower is not used for three consecutive months in the manner authorized by this Order. 3. Documents filed, if any, in the future pursuant to ordering paragraph 2 herein shall reference this case number and shall be retained in the post-case correspondence file. 4.
