	b. The estimated annual revenue to be lost due to adjustment of terminating access rates effective July
	1 , 2013.
	c. The total estimated annual revenue (increase or decrease) to be generated by the tariff changes.
	Include a breakout for each service or category of service to show changes in revenue.
