	construction will not result in a change in Sandy Hook's rates for service. Sandy Hook shall provide written notice of this additional construction in accordance with 807 KAR 5:069, Section 3.
	6. Sandy Hook shall file a copy of the "as-built" drawings and a certified
	statement from the engineer that the construction has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the contract plans and specifications within 60 days of substantial completion of the construction certified herein.
	7. Sandy Hook shall require the construction to be inspected under the
	general supervision of a professional engineer with a Kentucky registration in civil or
	mechanical engineering to ensure that the construction work is done in accordance with the contract drawings and specifications, and
