Order Entered: 1. This proceeding is established to investigate the reasonableness of the proposed Low-Income Weatherization Support Program. 2. BREC's proposed Low-Income Weatherization

Support Program is suspended for five months from June 15, 2019, up to and including November 14, 2019. 3. BREC shall file responses to the information request set forth in Appendix A no later than

June 25, 2019.

4. The procedural schedule set forth in Appendix B to this Order shall be followed. 5. a. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed and shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided, with copies to all parties of record, and the original and ten copies to the Commission. b. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership

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or an association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

c. A party shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect.
