Northern Kentucky District shall file with the Commission documentation of the total costs of this project, including the cost of construction and all other capitalized costs (e.g., engineering, legal, and administrative), within 60 days of the date that the project is substantially completed. 6. Any documents filed in the future pursuant to ordering paragraphs 2 and 5 of this Order shall reference this case number and shall be retained in the utility's post- case correspondence file. 7. The Executive Director is delegated authority to grant reasonable extensions of time for filing of any documents required by this Order upon Northern Kentucky District's showing of good cause for such extension. 8.
