Any material deviation from the construction approved by this Order shall be undertaken only with prior approval of the Commission. 4. Bluegrass Water shall file documentation of the total costs of the projects, including the cost of construction and all other capitalized costs, within 60 days of the date that construction authorized under this CPCN is substantially completed. 5. Bluegrass Water shall file a copy of the "as-built" drawings, if any, and a certified statement that the construction has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the plans and
	specifications within 60 days of the substantial completion of the construction certificated herein. 6. Any documents filed in the future pursuant to ordering paragraph 2 through 5 shall reference this case number and shall be retained in the post-case correspondence file for this proceeding. 7. The Executive Director is delegated authority to grant reasonable extensions of time for filing any documents required by this Order upon Bluegrass Water's showing of good cause for such extension. 8.
