	jurisdictional environmental revenue requirement by \$389,127 for one month.
	4. LG&E shall roll \$13,088,937 of incremental environmental surcharge amounts found to be just and reasonable herein into its existing base rates, for a total base rate environmental component of
	\$13,883,368. The roll-in shall be allocated to the customer classes as described in the Settlement Agreement approved in Case No. 2011-00161 and in Case No. 2011-00232.
	5. LG&E shall use an overall rate of return on capital of 7.14%, a return-on-equity rate of 10.25%, a tax gross-up factor of 0.64, and an overall grossed-up return of 10.26% in all monthly environmental surcharge filings subsequent to the date of this Order.
	6. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, LG&E shall file with the Commission revised tariffs reflecting the changes to its base rates as a result of the roll-in of environmental surcharge amounts described herein; the same type of supporting documentation it filed in Case No. 2011-00232; other
