**INDEX OF EVENTS:**

05/05/15 Final Order Entered: 1. TAG'S application for a declaratory order is granted as discussed in the findings above. 2. The monopole constructed by TAG at 4409 Kit Carson Drive, Richmond, Madison County, Kentucky, is located outside of the jurisdiction of a local planning commission, is subject to Commission jurisdiction and should not have been constructed without the prior issuance of a CPCN. 3. No action shall be taken against TAG for the imposition of penalties pursuant to KRS 278.990 for its failure to obtain a CPCN for the construction of the monopole. 4. Any entity that collocates on the monopole will not be subject to the imposition of penalties pursuant to KRS 278.990 for such collocation. 5. Any utility planning to collocate its antenna on the monopole shall notify the Commission pursuant to 807 KAR 5:063, Section 3. 6. The Commission will not require that the monopole be razed due to its construction without a CPCN. 7. TAG shall seek prior Commission approval before beginning construction of any antenna tower for cellular telecommunications service that is located outside of the jurisdiction of a local planning commission. 8. TAG shall immediately notify the Commission in writing if, after the monopole is built and utility service is commenced, the monopole is not used for a period of three months for the provision of utility service. 9. KCTA's motion for intervention is denied as moot.
