Meade County RECC is granted relief pursuant to 807 KAR 5:041 Section 22, from the periodic and statistical testing of meters required by 807 KAR 5:041 Section 16, for the duration of the project for the full deployment of the AMI meters on the condition that Meade County RECC test all of the old meters when removed from service for any cause. 3. Meade County RECC shall notify the Commission in writing within 30 days of the completion of the AMI deployment. Meade County RECC shall also provide a written proposal for the accounting treatment of the remaining depreciable balance of the TS2 meters. 4. Meade County RECC shall depreciate the new AMI system over a 15-year period. 5. This matter is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
