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## **PSC To Conduct Public Comments Meeting on Proposed Kentucky Utilities Transmission Facilities in Hardin County 6:00 p.m. E.T.**

**FRANKFORT, Ky. (May 5 2022)**—The Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC/Commission) will conduct a meeting to hear public comments regarding an application received by the Commission from Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) for the construction of transmission facilities. KU filed an application on March 31, 2022, seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct two 345 kV transmission lines, two 138 kV transmission lines, and two associated substations in Hardin County, Kentucky. According to KU's application, the transmission lines are necessary to provide electrical service to the Glendale Megasite, the location of Ford Motor Company's proposed battery manufacturing facilities.

The purpose of a public comments meeting is for the Commission to hear comments from non-intervening parties in a case. There will be a sign-in sheet at the meeting site for those wishing to make comments. Additional guidelines will be presented at the meeting, following a brief presentation by PSC staff about the proposed project.
