PSC To Hold Nuclear Technical Conference May 12 & 13 in Frankfort

FRANKFORT, Ky. (April 30, 2026) – Why is everyone talking about nuclear power these days? If you're curious, here is an opportunity to find out why nuclear power is back in the public conversation. The Kentucky Public Service Commission is currently studying nuclear energy, as directed by our state legislature in Senate Joint Resolution 140, and to further this study we are holding a nuclear conference on May 12 & 13 at the Kentucky History Center in Frankfort. We have invited experts from across the country to discuss various aspects of nuclear energy generation, including technology advancements, financing projects, environmental concerns, regulatory considerations, waste disposal issues, and community engagement.
