## PSC Plans Public Comment Meetings for Kentucky Power Rate Case No. 2025-00257

**FRANKFORT, Ky. (November 3, 2025)** – The Kentucky Public Service Commission will hold public comment meetings to provide an opportunity for the public to give comments regarding Kentucky Power's applications to adjust their tariffed rates. The application requests authorization to increase Kentucky Power's electric base rate total revenue by \$95,558,248. Residential customers would see an average monthly energy bill increase \$27.30 to \$210.67, up from an average bill of \$183.37. This represents an increase of approximately 14.62% percent

The PSC will hold three public comment hearings to provide a local opportunity for public comment. The meetings will be held at the following times and locations:

- **Pikeville**: November 20, 2025, 5 p.m. Eastern Standard Time, at the Pike County Public Library District: 126 Lee Avenue, Rooms 306-307, Pikeville, Kentucky 41501.

- **Ashland**: January 8, 2026, at 5 p.m. Eastern Standard Time, at the Ashland Transportation Center, 99 15th Street, Ashland, Kentucky 41101.

Kentucky Power is a jurisdictional electric utility that generates and purchases electricity that it distributes and sells at retail to approximately 162,511 customers located in all, or portions of Boyd, Breathitt, Carter, Clay, Elliott, Floyd, Greenup, Johnson, Knott, Lawrence, Leslie, Letcher, Lewis, Magoffin, Martin, Morgan, Owsley, Perry, Pike, and Rowan counties.1 Kentucky Power's last adjustment of its electric rates was in Case No. 2023-00159.

The PSC is an independent agency attached for administrative purposes to the Energy and Environment Cabinet. It regulates more than 1,100 gas, water, sewer, electric and telecommunication utilities operating in Kentucky and has approximately 90 employees.
