O R D E R

On October 17, 1980, the Attorney General's Consumer Intervention Division filed a Petition for Rehearing in the above case. On October 24, 1980, certain customers of Goshen Utilities, Inc. filed a Motion to Intervene and Petition for Rehearing. On October 27, 1980, Goshen Utilities, Inc., by counsel, filed its Motion to Dismiss and Response to Petition for Rehearing filed by the Consumer Intervention Division.


The Commission, having considered the Petition for Rehearing of the Consumer Intervention Division, the Motion to Intervene filed by certain customers of Goshen Utilities, Inc., and being advised, hereby ORDERS That the Petition for Rehearing of the Attorney General's Consumer Intervention Division be, and it hereby is, granted, and that the Motion to Intervene filed by certain customers of Goshen Utilities, Inc. be, and it hereby is, sustained.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That this case be, and it hereby is, set for hearing on November 14, 1980 at 3:00 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, at the Goshen Elementary School Gymnasium, Prospect, Kentucky. The hearing shall be for the purpose of receiving comments and/or written statements from affected customers of Goshen Utilities, Inc., and for additional testimony and cross examination.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the Commission reserves the right to affirm its Order entered September 26, 1980 in this proceeding.
